

Safety Advice

Please note the following to protect yourself when meeting a new connection. Always follow safety measures to protect you and your loved ones.

- **Do not** include the following in your profile;
 - ❖ Telephone number(s)
 - ❖ Street Address
 - ❖ Last name
 - ❖ E-mail address
 - ❖ Information on family members
 - ❖ Pictures that can easily identify your location
 - ❖ Fax number(s)
 - ❖ Pictures of family members (including minors)

- Do not rush into becoming familiar. Get to know the person before divulging private information and going on dates. With the passage of time, you should feel sufficiently comfortable to take this step of meeting. In the meantime, we strongly recommend that you use the services of FeelDLove such as the chat feature for conversations before divulging your mobile phone information.

- Do not agree to meet with someone (unless you are fully comfortable and feel that you know the person sufficiently) in a location that is considered secluded, isolated or unsafe, or where you perceive may be unsafe. FOLLOW YOUR GUT FEELINGS.

- In the event you wish to meet on dates, please use a public place for the first dates until you are comfortable with locations that offer less publicity. You can politely decline an offer to meet in a place you are likely to feel unsafe, or where you think you are being pressured to go to a private location or residence. Being pressured is ALWAYS a good reason NOT to pursue.

- Notify others of your plans to go on a first date by giving information of the name of the person and where you intend to go and, if plans change midway, send a message to that person or persons. Be sure to give an estimated time you are likely to be back.

- Be aware of your surrounding and take control of personal protection and safety including your personal valuables.

- Do not give out personal and private information such as details relating to bank accounts, including credit cards.
- Do not send money to another user, member or subscriber. Doing so, is at your own risk and liability.
- Follow your gut feelings or instincts when it comes to unusual behavior or questionable actions/occurrences. Most times you are likely to be right.
